## *How the intercultural relationships build new forms of human beings and inclusive communities*

### *WORKING PLAN*

#### *Phases:*

1. Preparation: February - August 2019
2. Participant selection: February - May 2019
3. Volunteering Activity preparation: June - August 2019
4. Implementation: 1 September 2019 – 1 September 2020 (15 September 2019 - 15 September for the placement Agape 2020)
5. Dissemination: September - October 2020

#### ***1•Preparation - FEBRUARY - AUGUST 2019***

The CO created a **Drive Folder** shared with all partner to share documents and information about the project.

The CO created and shared and **Info Pack and a Working Plan** with all partners. These documents are to share the information about the project and to manage the implementation of the project.

Diaconia Valdese will arrange volunteers accommodation, will meet placements and organize the work and the project with local tutors and mentor.

#### ***2•Participants Selection - FEBRUARY - MAY 2019***

The partner start to look for candidates.

- By the **15 of March 2019** they will send maximum three candidates to contact person of Diaconia Valdese.
- From **15th of March to 15th of May** Diaconia Valdese will organize skype meeting with candidates.
- By the **31st of May** Diaconia Valdese will communicate the selection results and the candidates will confirm their participation in EVS activities

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Candidates will provide:

- Application Form
- European CV
- Motivation Letter

Partners should upload these documents in the drive folders, everyone in the dedicated folder.

### ***3. Volunteering Activity preparation - JUNE - AUGUST 2019***

Partners organize **Pre-Departure** training for volunteers, organizing seminars or individual meeting.

Partners organize preparation for the volunteers using *ESC Info-kit ("What to expect from the European Solidarity Corps")* and giving information about the placements. These documents will be shared in Drive folder<sup>1</sup>.

Partner should also give proper information about the project, the objectives, the workshop and the final event.

Partner should also train the volunteer for the experience, to let them achieve the proper competences to deal with cultural shock, a long-term volunteering experience, intercultural dialogue, group work, crisis and conflict management.

Partners will enroll selected volunteers for the **ESC insurance CIGNA**.

CO will be in contact with the volunteers to organize their **arrival in Italy**. The volunteers will be in charge of buying their own tickets. CO will reimburse the volunteers' tickets **at the end of the service** once the volunteers will send all the used tickets and original boarding pass.

The volunteers have the following budget for their **travel** (roundtrip):

From Spain, Serbia, Hungary and Kosovo: 275,00 euro

From Georgia and Turkey: 360,00 euro

Volunteers will receive a pocket money of 150/155 euro a month.

They will receive a monthly sum to provide themselves food (except Agape Ecumenical Centre)

Partner can establish a monitoring calendar for the volunteers and schedule regular skype meetings or e-mail contacts during their year in Italy to keep constantly in contact with them.

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<sup>1</sup> The participant must receive the European Solidarity Corps Info Kit and be adequately prepared by the supporting organisation for the stay abroad, according to their needs and in line with the European Solidarity Corps Training and Evaluation Cycle guidelines and minimum quality standards.

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## 4-Implementation - 2 September 2019 - 1 September 2020 (16 September 2019 - 15 September for the placement Agape 2020)

### *Activities:*

- One volunteer from Serbia at Il Passo Social Point, Torino.
- One volunteer from Hungary at Il Passo Social Point, Torino.
- One volunteer from Spain at Radio Beckwith, Luserna S.Giovanni.
- One volunteer from Kosovo at Radio Beckwith, Luserna S.Giovanni.
- One volunteer from Turkey at the Service for Refugees and Asylum Seekers, Luserna S.Giovanni.
- One volunteer from Georgia at Agape, Prali (*Mobility: 15 September 2019 - 15 September for the placement Agape 2020*).

The volunteers will be asked every month to write an article for the project's blog: <https://interreligiousmulticultural.wordpress.com/>

Diaconia Valdese as coordinating organization will offer the volunteers 3 seminars:

- *On-Arrival Seminar* in September/October 2019
- *Mid-Term Seminar* at the beginning of February 2020 in Florence
- *Final Seminar* at the end of May/beginning of June 2020 in Palermo and in Luserna San Giovanni

Furthermore the volunteers will attend 2 more seminars organized from the Italian National Agency.

The volunteers will be offered a **language course** every week from September 2019 till May 2020. After the Mid-Term seminar the volunteers will start to complete their **Youthpass**, the profile will be opened by CO.

The project proposes a learning path with the development of Volunteering "community based" activities and a specific workshop dedicated to the representation of experience through illustration. The involved volunteers will organize one final event in Turin (July 2020) in order to share all the illustrating works (Zine), they have created at the end of the workshop.

The event will be transmitted in Facebook live and all partner organizations and stakeholders will be invited to follow. The project will allow the volunteer to achieve key competences, that they cannot achieve in formal education paths. Products, video and picture will be shared in the project's blog and the social networks.

After the events the volunteers will receive their Youthpass.

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## ***5-Dissemination - September - October 2020***

The volunteers will propose the same final events back in their origin communities with the support of the **supporting organization**. Products, video and picture will be shared in the project's blog and the social networks.

Partners will be asked to complete **an evaluation form** about the whole project.
